7. 472 South Spalding Drive Central R-1 Permit

Request for a Central R-1 Permit to allow a first-story 60 square foot addition, a secondstory 151 square foot addition to an existing two-story accessory structure, and to allow a detached second unit to be located above the ground floor to exceed 14 feet in height. Pursuant to the provisions set forth in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Planning Commission will also consider adoption of a Categorical Exemption for this project.

- City Planner Updates
 - City Planner Ryan Gohlich provided updates on the following:
 - The Lexus / Infiniti transition at 9031 and 9001 Olympic Boulevard is currently underway.
 - The appeal of the Planning Commission's decision for the project at 9570 Virginia Place is scheduled to be heard at the December 6, 2016 City Council formal meeting.
 - The appeal of the Planning Commission's decision for the project at 332-336 North Oakhurst Drive is expected to be heard at the December 20, 2016 City Council formal meeting.
 - Public comment was received at the November 9, 2016 City Council meeting suggesting that demolition activity at 332-336 North Oakhurst Drive had begun. Staff immediately sent Building Inspectors to the site, at which time no demolition or construction activity was observed, nor was there indication that any demolition or construction activity had previously taken place.
 - Also related to the project at 332-336 North Oakhurst Drive, the CEQA lawsuit that was filed against the City of Los Angeles and the developer of the project was dismissed by the Court.
 - The Zone Text Amendment for pet boarding at Pussy and Pooch at 9388 South Santa Monica Boulevard is scheduled to be heard at the November 15, 2016 City Council formal meeting.
 - The One Beverly Hills project has been discussed at a series of recent City Council meetings. A motion was made, directing the City Attorney to prepare the Ordinance and Resolutions that would allow for approval of the project.
 - Staff anticipates that permits will soon be issued to begin work on the O'Gara Coach project at 8955 Olympic Boulevard.
