DESCRIPTION:

A curious but not unheard of mixture of architectural elements appears in this 1915 house. Box-like massing, a flat roof hidden by a molded parapet, and stucco siding indicate Mission Revival or Mediterranean influences. So, too, do the skirt roof punctuated by decorated modillions and the mission tile used on the porch roof. The porch, however, is symmetrically located at the northeast corner of the house and its roof is gabled and braced in the Craftsman manner. Tripartite windows on the upper story also suggest Craftsman inspiration. Representative of a particular decade in Southern California building, this intact home is a rare example of its type in the western Los Angeles region.
