



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

July 30, 2013

Dear Residents/Community Members:

The City of Beverly Hills has contracted with All American Asphalt to resurface and repair several residential streets and alleys. The work includes removing and reconstructing damaged curb and gutter, sidewalks, and repaving.

When (excluding holidays and weekends):

- Thursday August 8, 2013 – Cold Mill of Pavement
- Friday August 9, 2013 –Paving

Where:

- Beverly Drive between Cold Water Canyon Dr. and Sutton Way

What to Expect:

- Work hours are typically Monday through Friday 8AM-5PM.
- Two or three crews of about 8 people and a paver or milling machine (picture), dump truck, utility truck and pick-up truck working in the alley.
- Some noise from equipment operating.
- Some “No Parking” signs.
- Street will be cleared at the end of each working day and re-opened for regular use.

- The City of Beverly Hills is conducting this work as part of their street and alley rehabilitation program to maintain the quality of the city's infrastructure.

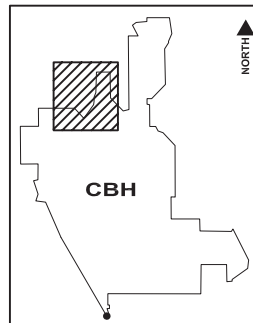
