Applications for the Recreation & Parks Commission may be obtained from the City Clerk's Office. Following these interviews, the subcommittee will recommend the names of one or more top candidates to the full City Council. City Councilmembers may then conduct further interviews before they make a final selection at a formal City Council meeting.
