- **Tweens** (entering 4th & 5th Grades) and **Teens** (entering 6th-12th Grades) may sign up in the Children’s Library, during library hours, starting **May 22**, OR
- Registration may also be completed online at www.bhpl.org, starting **May 22**.

Each participant receives a reading log, which is used to track time spent reading. The goal is to read for **25 hours**.

- Once they’ve read for **12.5 hours**, they’ll receive a prize;
- Once they’ve read for **25 hours**, they’ll get to choose a free paperback book.

Participation counts towards Beverly Hills Unified School District’s Summer Reading Medal Incentive program. The last day for Tweens & Teens to report their reading progress is **August 18**.
