**BEVERLY HILLS CITY COUNCIL TO DISCUSS LA COUNTY HEALTH
OFFICER ORDER AT DEC. 1 MEETING**

Council Will Review County's Closure of In-Person Dining

Beverly Hills, CA – The Beverly Hills City Council will review the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health's recent Health Officer Order that prohibits indoor and outdoor in-person dining at its December 1 Study Session.

The County of Los Angeles modified its Health Order to allow only delivery, drive-thru services and takeout at restaurants, bars, breweries and wineries for a minimum of three weeks beginning at 10 p.m. Wednesday, November 25.

At the December 1 meeting, City Council will discuss the detrimental impact of the Order on Beverly Hills' businesses as well as the options it can take concerning this item.
