Roxbury Park Community Center Closed November 28 *City Takes Precautionary Measures after Reports of Bedbugs*

Beverly Hills, Calif. – Roxbury Park Community Center is closed this afternoon, November 28, as a precautionary measure due to reports of bedbugs. A professional exterminating company will fumigate the building and continue to work with the city for ongoing treatment and control. The City is following and exceeding all recommended protocols for treatment of bedbugs.

While Roxbury Park Community Center will be closed, the outdoor area of the park remains open. All Community Center classes scheduled for November 28 will be canceled and participants will be notified.

Bedbugs are very common in Los Angeles County. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, bed bugs are not known to spread disease, but can be a nuisance if the problem is not controlled.
