Beverly Hills Offers Safety Driver Program to Seniors *Program Designed to Help Elderly Drivers be Independent, Safe and Confident*

Beverly Hills, Calif. – The City of Beverly Hills cares about the safety of elderly drivers! The City is offering AARP Safety Driver Program at Roxbury Park Community Center, 471 South Roxbury Drive, Beverly Hills. This program will help elderly drivers remain independent, safe and confident while on the road. This program offers a two-part course that takes place on consecutive Sundays: March 5 and March 12 from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

This program will allow participants to understand how cars and technology inside the cars have changed. Besides reviewing basic rules and covering new laws, they will receive additional training with roundabouts, pavement markings, stop-sign compliance, red-light running and other safety issues such as speeding, and seatbelt and turn signal usage. Upon completion of classes, students will receive a Department of Motor Vehicle Certificate for discounts on automobile insurance.
