

Strict symmetry governs the appearance of this two story, American Colonial Revival house. Sheathed in dark shingles, the structure is capped by a side gable roof with a molded cornice. The entry is centered, flat-headed, and topped by an arched pediment of exaggerated proportions. Panelling characterizes both the door and the reveals. Panelled bases beneath the shuttered double-hung sash in the side bays of the three bay facade reiterate the motif. The second story also contains shuttered, double-hung sash, paired on the sides, single in the center. All of the windows are detailed with denticulated lintels. A broad brick chimney terminates the structure on the south.
