

## **MULTI-FAMILY WATER SAVING TIPS FOR OWNERS**



The City of Beverly Hills encourages everyone to use water efficiently. The following water conservation tips will help you and your Tenants:

- Encourage tenants to report leaky faucets and running toilets, and repair them immediately. Test toilets by ordering dye tabs from the City (see below).
- Install high efficiency toilets (rebate).
- Install low flow showerheads.
- Install aerators on kitchen and bathroom faucets.
- Install high efficiency clothes washers (rebate).
- During regular building inspections, check all toilets for leaks.
- Follow the City's outdoor watering code of 2 days per week October thru May and 3 days a week June thru September.
- Sign up for the City's FREE Water Tracking program at Water.BeverlyHills.org
