Two Ballot Drop-Off Locations Created for Beverly Hills Municipal Election *Officials at City Hall and Courthouse Are Now Accepting Ballots*

Beverly Hills - Beverly Hills residents now have another convenient option for voting in the March 7 municipal election. In addition to sending a ballot in the mail or voting in person on Election Day, voters may drop off their vote-by-mail ballots at the City Clerk's Office at City Hall or the Beverly Hills Courthouse.

This year Beverly Hills voters will select a new City Treasurer and vote for three open seats on the City Council. Voters may apply for a vote-by-mail ballot by going to www.lavote.net or by calling the Los Angeles County Registrar's Office at (800) 815-2666. Vote-by-mail applications must be received by Feb. 28.
