Arrest of Prowling Suspect in Stolen Vehicle

The Beverly Hills Police Department has made two arrests in connection with a residential prowling incident.

On September 15, 2017, at approximately 12:45 p.m., Beverly Hills Police received a report of a residential burglary in progress in the 600-block of North Roxbury Drive. The resident called Police after he observed a male subject on his property tampering with a window of the residence.

Beverly Hills Patrol officers quickly arrived and observed a vehicle fleeing the scene. It was later determined that that vehicle had been reported stolen from the City of Los Angeles earlier that same day. Officers stopped the vehicle and made contact with the driver, Jonathan Enrique Herrera, and a passenger, Larry Eugene Shipp.

Officers conducted a field investigation and determined that Herrera was the subject prowling on the victim's property.

Jonathan Enrique Herrera, 27, of Los Angeles, was arrested for Driving a Stolen Vehicle, Prowling, Burglary and Possession of Narcotics Paraphernalia. Larry Eugene Shipp, 65, of Los Angeles, was arrested for a No-Bail Parole warrant. At the time of the arrest, Shipp was on active Post Release Community Supervision for Robbery.

Beverly Hills Detectives completed additional follow-up investigation and later presented the case to the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office. Herrera was charged with **Prowling** (§647(h) – a misdemeanor). No charges were filed against Shipp; however, he remains in custody for the warrant.

Herrera is scheduled to appear at the Airport Courthouse on October 12, 2017.
