## **City Council Will Consider Police Management Association Agreement at the June 13<sup>th</sup> City Council Meeting**

Beverly Hills, CA – The Beverly Hills City Council will consider the memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the Beverly Hills Police Management Association (BHPMA) at the Tue., June 13, 2017 City Council Formal Session. Approval of the MOU is subject to ratification by members of the BHPMA as well as adoption of the City Council.

This MOU is the result of labor negotiations between the City and representatives of the employee group. The proposed MOU covers salaries and benefits for a three-year period from October 7, 2016 through September 30, 2019. The Police Management Association represents police captains and police lieutenants.

The proposed MOU, an independent fiscal analysis of the cost of the MOU and a summary of significant terms are posted on the City's website at [www.beverlyhills.org/mou](http://www.beverlyhills.org/mou).

There are nine represented employee associations within the City. The City is currently in multi-year agreements with the Police Officers' Association, Firefighters' Association, and the six miscellaneous (non-safety) employee associations.
