Meet Bestselling Author Delia Ephron *Beverly Hills Public Library June 14*



Beverly Hills, Calif. – Join us at the Beverly Hills Public Library, 444 North Rexford Drive, on Wednesday, June 14 at 7 p.m. and meet bestselling author and screenwriter Delia Ephron, who will speak about her most recent novel, *Siracusa*. *Siracusa* follows two couples and a child on a vacation in Italy. Told Rashomon-style with alternating points of view, the couples stumble upon lies and infidelities past and present. While *Siracusa* has the pace of a psychological thriller, it is also an exploration of marriage, motherhood, friendship and the meaning of travel. Ephron will also speak about her inspiration and writing process. Books will be available for sale and signing following the program.

Ephron is an accomplished author and screenwriter. Her novels include *The Lion In* and *Hanging Up*; humor books, include *How to Eat Like a Child* and *Do I Have to Say Hello?*; and most recent nonfiction book is, *Sister Mother Husband Dog (etc.)*. Ephron's films include *You've Got Mail*, *The Sisterhood of the Traveling Pants*, *Hanging Up* and *Michael*. Her hit play, *Love, Loss, and What I Wore*, ran for more than two years off-Broadway and has been performed all over the world.

The New York Times recently ran Ephron's op-ed, [*After 54 Years, We Fell in Love. After Five Months, I Got Leukemia*](#), in which she shares her story about the loss of her husband and finding love again with a man she met 54 years earlier, only to be diagnosed with Leukemia weeks later after meeting her new love. Ephron is now in remission, married to her new love and is back to writing for a living.
