1) Public Comment

2) Facilities / Maintenance

- City Manager Mahdi Aluzri and Assistant Director Public Works Chad Lynn discussed various details of the Wallis Annenberg budget and addressed possible terms under which the City might accommodate the Wallis Annenberg Center for Performing Arts request for funding.
- Mayor Julian Gold, Councilmember Lili Bosse, and City Manager Mahdi Aluzri recommended to Rachael Fine and MeraLee Goldman that they attend June 5, 2018 Study Session where the Wallis Annenberg budget will be included as part of citywide budget discussions.

3) Campus Security:

- City Manager Mahdi Aluzri indicated that the City would continue to assist in developing a security plan for Wallis Annenberg Center for Performing Arts.
- Chief of Police Sandra Spagnoli presented options for security enhancements including equipment and additional staff time with an initial cost of approximately \$55,000, and a recurring cost of \$150,000.

- Councilmember Lili Bosse raised issues of security check procedures and the use of metal detectors. Mayor Julian Gold suggested any security check system would have to be branded for the lobby in a way that is unique to Wallis Annenberg Center.
- Mayor Julian Gold asked Chief Spagnoli to look into facial recognition technology options.
- Chief Spagnoli also recommended that the Wallis Annenberg hire a Security Risk Manager to access security issues.
