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Human Relations Commission Invites Tenants and Landlords to Their Special Meeting

Beverly Hills, Calif. – The Human Relations Commission invites all tenants and landlords to come together to share ideas and concerns regarding the recently enacted Urgency Ordinance amending the Beverly Hills Rent Stabilization Municipal Code.

The Urgency Ordinance limits tenant rent increases to 3% annually, and includes an update to the Municipal code, requiring a payment of a relocation fee for Chapter 6 tenants from \$9,050 to \$21,650 with the issuance of a 60-day no-cause termination notice.
