Dear Resident:

#### Non-Compliance Notice Subject:

Recent inspections of the alleys in the area indicated that refuse is not being placed properly in containers, but is being left on the ground in the alley. For boxes, please break down boxes before placing them into the container. For larger boxes that are too large to be placed in containers break them down and place them next to your container.

Bulky item pick-up and alley maintenance services are provided twice a month to collect items and yard debris too large to fit in containers. The alley service schedule is as follows:

- Allevs located North of Santa Monica Blvd. are serviced every 1st and 3rd week of the month.
- Allevs located South of Santa Monica Blvd. are serviced every 2nd and 4th week of the month.

For large boxes and bulky items that would take up space if placed in trash containers, Breakdown boxes and place boxes or bulky items next to the container and call Public Works Customer Service at (310) 285-2467 for a special pick-up. You also can email. AskPW@beverlyhills.org, When placing items next to the container, please provide clearance for the collection truck and do not block the alley or pathway.

The City seeks to ensure all residents enjoy the full complement of services attendant to living within the City. An important goal of the City is to comply with, and where possible exceed, health and safety standards by avoiding any accumulations of waste in alleys. Our scenic beauty is one reason residents live in the City and invest in their properties each year.

Randomly discarded trash, even the smallest item, endangers our environment. Please help prevent the accumulation of waste and litter in the alleyways by properly disposing of trash in containers and when items cannot fit or take up too much space, please call for a special pick-up.

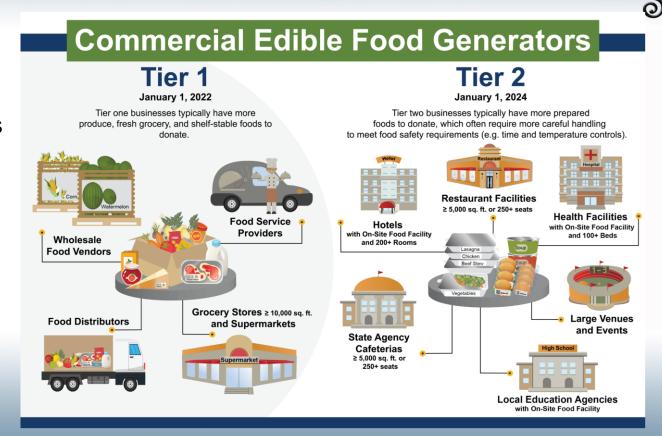
