



NIBRS Offense Definitions

Crime Category	Sub-Category	NIBRS OFFENSE CODE	Description
ANIMAL CRUELTY	Animal Cruelty	720	Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly taking an action that mistreats or kills any animal without just cause, such as torturing, tormenting, mutilation, maiming, poisoning, or abandonment. Included are instances of duty to provide care, e.g., shelter, food, water, care if sick or injured; transporting or confining an animal in a manner likely to cause injury or death; causing an animal to fight with another; inflicting excessive or repeated unnecessary pain or suffering, e.g., uses objects to beat or torture an animal
ASSAULT	Assault – Aggravated	13A	An assault with a weapon or with the intent to inflict severe or aggravated bodily injury.
	Assault – Simple	13B	An assault with no intent and not resulting in severe or aggravated bodily injury.
	Assaults – Prior to Sept 2018	13C	All aggravated and simple assaults (previously combined).
BURGLARY	Burglary – Commercial Building	220	Entry into a commercial business after business hours with the intent to commit theft
	Burglary – Construction Site	220	Any entry onto a construction site with intent to commit theft.
	Burglary – Residential (Accessed Garage Only)	220	Entry <u>limited</u> to a garage (subterranean, attached to residence, detached from residence) with intent to commit theft.
	Burglary – Residential (Home Occupied)	220	Entry into a residence with the intent to commit a theft or any felony while the residence is occupied at the time of the crime.
