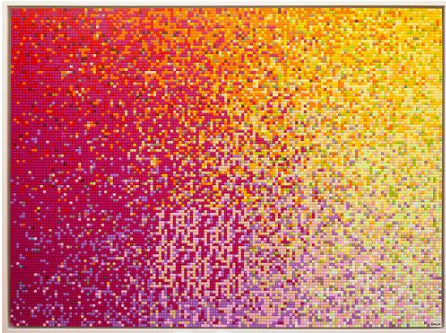




Los Angeles Art Association

Andy Bauch, Space 226A

Andy Bauch's series, New Money, is an abstract series made with a very specific, tactile toy - LEGOs. The siren call and threat of the new, abstract systems of money, like bitcoin and cannabiscoin, are represented by the digital coding that created them, and have titles like "Swagbucks Initially Valued at \$10.00". 1X1 legos stand in for pixels. The analogies get headier and trippier after that. His New Money lego art explores the value of traditional, physical art, and in a sense, our physical, non-digital lives.

Stuart Needman, Space 226A

Stuart Needman creates cautionary sculptures about the environment and the condition of our oceans, lakes, rivers, and water supplies. Art critic and curator Peter Frank said this about Needman's work: "Playful as Needman's expansively-sized, extravagantly built objects in two and three dimensions may be, they mean business...The artist finds not only the pain and confusion in human existence, but its rollicking absurdity as well...They play with meaning, with material, with color and texture, with presence, and with an abiding sense of poetics." www.stuneedman.com/free-standing
