DESCRIPTION

- 7b. Briefly describe the present *physical description* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

The Beverly Hills Women's Club is a one story building in the Spanish Colonial Revival style. Stucco-clad, the structure is capped by a tiled hip roof. The principal entry faces Chevy Chase Drive, and is framed in terra cotta or cast stone. Pilasters, scrolled brackets, and an entablature topped by a broken pediment with a shield and urn motif are incorporated into the door surround. Other notable features include casement windows, some ornamented with rejas, and a porte cochere on the Benedict Canon Drive elevation. Surrounded by trees and lawns, the clubhouse is integrated in design and scale with the surrounding neighborhood of single family homes.






