



Multi-family Water Saving Tips

These are suggestions on ways to save water in multi-family residential buildings.

For Tenants

Every tenant can have an impact on saving water, and when combining all the efforts of other tenants in a multi-family building, significant water savings are possible.

Here are some easy ways to save water:

- Install **aerators on all faucets**
- Install a **low-flow showerhead**, or check with your landlord about installing
- **Shorten your shower** to save dozens of gallons per month
- Install a **high-efficiency toilet**, or check with your landlord about installing
- **Turn off water when brushing teeth or shaving**
- **Capture water in your sink when washing vegetables.** Use this water for plants.
- **Capture water in a bucket when warming up a shower.** Use this water for plants.
- **Report leaks immediately** for faucets, toilets or outdoor sprinklers
- **Report outdoor sprinkler runoff or overspraying**
