

Multi-family Water Saving Tips

These are suggestions on ways to save water in multi-family residential buildings.

For Tenants

Every tenant can have an impact on saving water, and when combining all the efforts of other tenants in a multi-family building, significant water savings are possible.

Here are some easy ways to save water:

- Install aerators on all faucets
- Install a low-flow showerhead, or check with your landlord about installing
- Shorten your shower to save dozens of gallons per month
- Install a high-efficiency toilet, or check with your landlord about installing
- Turn off water when brushing teeth or shaving
- Capture water in your sink when washing vegetables. Use this water for plants.
- Capture water in a bucket when warming up a shower. Use this water for plants.
- Report leaks immediately for faucets, toilets or outdoor sprinklers
- Report outdoor sprinkler runoff or overspraying
