NOTICE OF COMMISSION VACANCIES:

RENT STABILIZATION COMMISSION

The Beverly Hills City Council is seeking qualified residents to fill nine vacancies on the Rent Stabilization Commission as follows: two members representing the landlord group, two members representing the tenant group, two at-large members (non-landlord and non-tenant), and three alternate members for all groups. The initial term of office for the position is for two years. At the discretion of the City Council, the Commissioner may be reappointed to a second term of four years. The appointees will be required to file an initial and an annual "Statement of Economic Interests" financial disclosure.

In order that we may preserve the integrity of the application and interview process, please direct all inquiries to the Assistant City Clerk, City Manager, Deputy Director of Rent Stabilization, or the Director of Community Development. Please DO NOT contact the City Councilmembers regarding the vacancies.
