More than 65% of the water consumed in Beverly Hills is used for landscaping and lawns.

### **Goal**

Reduce water use while maintaining a garden-like quality in the City

### **What can you do?**

- Water landscaping only after sunset and before 7 am, take shorter showers, and only wash full loads of laundry
- Capture rainwater in rain barrels or cisterns or install a greywater system to water your plants
- Install a "smart" sprinkler controller, and fix leaky faucets and irrigation lines

### **What the City is doing:**

- Requiring City irrigation systems to be equipped with smart irrigation controllers
- Offering an online service that allows residents to track their water usage
- Planting trees and shrubs that require less water in City parks and landscaping
