IT'S SHOWTIME AT YOUR LIBRARY!

Dear Families:

The 2019 “It’s Showtime at Your Library!” Summer Reading Club offers fun for readers of all ages!

This is how the Summer Reading Club works:

Children may sign up in the Children’s Library, during library hours, starting **May 22** OR
Registration may also be completed online at www.bhpl.org, starting **May 22**.

The last day for children to report their reading progress is **August 18**.

Each child receives a reading log which is used to track time spent reading. They can report on their reading progress in one of three ways:

- Write a written report (forms available at the library, or online);
- Draw a picture (forms available at the library, or online);
- Tell a librarian about a favorite part of the book.

The Summer Reading Club goal is to read for 25 hours. We want to encourage children to become life-long readers and learners.

Once children have read for 12.5 hours, they’ll get to select three bookmarks.

Once they’ve read for 25 hours, they’ll get to choose a free paperback book.

Participation in the Library Summer Reading Club also counts towards the Beverly Hills Unified School District’s Summer Reading Medalist Incentive program.
