DESCRIPTION:

An American Colonial Revival dwelling, this is a two story, clapboard building topped by a side gable roof. The major portion of the facade is symmetrical in design, with exceptions caused by an extension to the north and by a one and two story wing recessed on the south. Beneath a boxed cornice, the house displays shuttered double-hung sash to which security grilles have been added. A central entry, flanked by pilasters, is framed by pilasters, frieze, and a scrolled broken pediment of exaggerated scale. Although substantially altered, the house contributes to the grouping in that its core is original and its Colonial Revival theme is compatible with other homes of its era.
