An American Colonial Revival dwelling, this is a two story, clapboard building topped by a side gable roof. The major portion of the facade is symmetrical in design, with exceptions caused by an extension to the north and by a one and two story wing recessed on the south. Beneath a boxed cornice, the house displays shuttered double-hung sash to which security grilles have been added. A central entry, flanked by pilasters, is framed by pilasters, frieze, and a scrolled broken pediment of exagger-ated scale. Although substantially altered, the house contributes to the grouping in that its core is original and its Colonial Revival theme is compatible with other homes of its era.
