Briefly describe the present physical appearance of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition: This is a two story theater and store building designed originally in a Moorish style but radically altered now. A new facade has obliterated the series of two story arches along Beverly Drive and substituted a series of vertical stripes and meshwork, slats and a large neon marquee flush against the wall above the theater entrance. Originally crenellated parapets have been smoothed out. What remains is an enormous spired dome over the center of the structure and four small minarets along the top of the facade.
