



His first novel, *Samurai Shortstop*, was named one of the American Library Association's Top Ten Best Books for Young Adults. His second novel, *Something Rotten*, was an ALA Quick Pick for Young Adult Readers. His latest book, *Refugee*, spent more than half a year on the New York Times bestseller list, and has received numerous awards, including the Sydney Taylor Book Award, the

National Jewish Book Award, the Cybils Middle Grade Fiction Award, a Charlotte Huck Award Honor, and a Malka Penn Award for Human Rights Honor. 
