Fall Beverly Hills artSHOW Winners Announced Local, Regional, and National Artists Recognized with First Place Honors

Beverly Hills, Calif. -- The Beverly Hills artSHOW held this past weekend in Beverly Gardens Park brought an estimated 30,000 visitors to Beverly Hills where 250 artists exhibited their work in the open outdoors along four blocks of Santa Monica Boulevard from Rodeo Drive to Rexford Drive. As always, the artists were selected by a panel of independent fine art professionals.

Art lovers enjoyed work in ceramics, digital art, drawing & printmaking, furnishings, glass, jewelry, photography, two-dimensional and three-dimensional mixed media, painting, sculpture and watercolor. Eight of the fourteen top awards were presented to artists in Southern California. The category winners are:
