Dear Mr. Welch and Mr. Comorre:

Environmental Intelligence, LLC (EI) has been retained by the City of Beverly Hills (COBH) and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) to serve as the independent compliance monitor (ICM) during the construction of the Purple Line Extension Project. Monitoring is required to ensure that construction is in compliance with (1) the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for Southern California Edison's (SCE's) Advance Utilities Relocation Phase of the Purple Line Extension Project – Segment 2 – Between the City of Beverly Hills and the Los Angeles Metropolitan Transportation Authority (City Agreement No. 384-17), (2) the MOA for the Third Party Advance Utility Relocation Phase of the Purple Line Extension Project – Section 2 - Between the City of Beverly Hills and the Los Angeles Metropolitan Transportation Authority (City Agreement No. 648-17) and (3) the Agreement titled "Demolition and Public Right-of-Way Use Permit for the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority and its Contractor to Clear All Buildings and Existing Improvements at 9430 Wilshire Boulevard, Install Noise Monitoring Equipment and Sound Walls for Future Construction and a Laydown Area for the Wilshire/Rodeo Station of Section Two of the Purple Line Extension Project" (Agreement dated June 5th, 2018). The following information summarizes the ICM monitoring activities that occurred at the Segment 2 site (Rodeo Station site) during the week of December 9, 2018 - December 15, 2018. Construction activities were not conducted on December 9 or 15.

Construction activities during the week included breaking down and processing demolition debris, hauling demolition debris and equipment off-site, removing the Ace Gallery foundation and column footings, beginning to grade the Ace Gallery yard, as well as placing aesthetic coverings on perimeter fencing. EI ICMs were present during all construction activities and conducted routine noise measurements at selected noise monitoring locations as well as compliance checks in accordance with the MOAs and associated attachments, exhibits, traffic closure notifications, and traffic management plans. At the conclusion of each work shift, daily monitoring reports were prepared by each ICM. Attachment A (*Daily Monitoring Report Summaries*) provides detailed daily monitoring reports and photographs of construction activities.

VIOLATION SUMMARY

During the week, EI ICMs identified no violations during construction activities. Daily monitoring reports and photographs of construction activities are provided as Attachment A (*Daily Monitoring Reports*). Daily noise monitoring data are provided in Attachment B (*Noise Monitoring Data Log*).

To date, 45 violations have been issued, four (4) of which have been rescinded since the beginning of construction of the Purple Line Extension Project – Segment 2. Project construction activities are ongoing and EI ICMs continue to monitor all construction activities applicable to the MOA on a daily basis.

Work for the day included processing demolition debris, hauling demolition debris off-site, and removing the foundation at the northeast corner of the Ace Gallery yard.

At 13:50 hours, the ICM Josh Stanford observed Silverado Contractors breaking and removing the foundation at the northeast corner of the Ace Gallery yard. Before starting this work, noise blankets around the northeast corner of the yard were removed from the fence and draped over the top of the fence (see photo 2444). Setting up the noise blankets in this manner does not sufficiently enclose the noise-producing activity. This activity approaches a violation, as Ace Gallery Demolition Permit Conditions 17 and 52 state that noise-producing activities and equipment shall be enclosed to the extent possible. The ICM notified Metro Inspector Luis Garcia of the issue. The noise blankets were promptly reinstalled on the interior of the perimeter fence (see photo 2445), and a violation was not issued.

The ICM notified Metro Inspector Luis Garcia of the issue, and the issue was immediately rectified. A violation was not issued.

At 14:20 hours, the ICM Daniel Chang observed that the sidewalks and alley around the perimeter of the Ace Gallery yard were dirty (see photo 1195). The ICM notified Metro Inspector Luis Garcia of the issue, and the issue was resolved within ten minutes.
