

PROJECT NOTICE

REVISED DATE: 1-7-2021

Dear Residents and Business Operators,

The first phase of the City's Sewer and Storm Drain Rehabilitation project entailed spot repairs and pipe lining, which started in late 2019 and anticipated for completion by February 2021. The remaining work described in this notice is limited to cleaning and CCTV inspection of City sewer mains through May 2021.

What to Expect:

- Access to your alley and street may be partially blocked temporarily. A contractor representative will always be on-site to provide access, as needed.
- Cleaning and inspection trucks, crews, and related equipment will be on-site near sewer manholes.
- Some noise and dust from maintenance activities.
- Traffic control devices, such as closed signs, cones, and delineators will be on-site.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted along the work areas

WHAT:

The City of Beverly Hills contracted with Southwest Pipeline & Trenchless Corporation (Southwest) to inspect and rehabilitate City sewer mains.

The work is limited to cleaning and closed circuit television (CCTV) inspection of City sewer main pipelines.

WHEN:

- Tentatively **January 19, 2021 through May 2021** (weather permitting).
- Typical work hours will be **Monday through Friday, 8am to 6pm** (may vary depending on locations).
- Depending on the sewer pipe length, cleaning and inspection will not take more than 2 hours per sewer main, aligned from manhole to manhole.

WHERE:

Various locations throughout the City of Beverly Hills, in the street or alley adjacent to residents or business properties.

If impacted sewer mains align within private properties, access to resident or business properties will be requested with advanced notice
