CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS TENNIS & PICKLEBALL REGULATIONS

AMENDED JANUARY 2024

- 1. Account registration with the Community Services Department is mandatory. Tennis/Pickleball membership is required to reserve a court.
- 2. Court reservations are accepted ONLINE and over the PHONE. Drop-in reservations or walk-ups will not be accepted for both tennis and pickleball.
- 3. Use of another person's Tennis/Pickleball membership to make reservations or using your membership to make a reservation for another person, is prohibited and may result in the suspension of your membership.
- 4. Each Tennis/Pickleball membership holder is allowed to make no more than two single court reservations per day, for a maximum of one hour for each court reservation. If making a two-hour court reservation, you will need to book each hour separately. This allows patrons to reserve a maximum of two hours per day.
- 5. Upon arrival at the facility, the Tennis/Pickleball membership holder identified on the court reservation is required to check-in with staff at the tennis office and indicate how many playing partners will be in attendance.
- 6. Tennis/Pickleball membership holders who are not present to check-in at the facility, and/or are not present during their court reservation, may have their membership suspended until staff review the incident with the membership holder.
- 7. Cancellation of your court reservation must be done at least four (4) hours in advance. Failure to cancel your court reservation will result in the loss of your full court reservation payment.
- 8. Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your reservation. If you do not arrive within the first 15 minutes of your court reservation time, your reservation will be cancelled, and you will be charged the full payment of your court reservation.
- 9. Either singles play or doubles play is permitted.

- 10. Tennis ball machines are available to rent at both the La Cienega Tennis Center, and the Roxbury Park Tennis courts. Personal tennis ball machines may be allowed with prior approval. Please email Lisa Castaneda at lcastaneda@beverlyhills.org for application and waiver form.
- 11. Please be mindful of your court reservation start and end time. All patrons should completely exit the court by reservation end time.
- 12. No professional teaching is allowed at any of our City facilities with the exception of City sponsored programs and City authorized contractors, such as Beverly Hills Tennis.
- 13. A maximum of ten (10) tennis balls or pickle balls are allowed on the court for 2 or more players. Ball hoppers are not permitted on the court except for City sponsored programs and City authorized contractors, such as Beverly Hills Tennis.
- 14. Locker rooms are for the use of Tennis/Pickleball membership holders and their guests. Providing locker room access to non-authorized users may result in the suspension of court and locker room privileges.
- 15. Although every effort will be made to accommodate a court request, court assignments are made at the discretion of the Community Services Department staff and may change without notice.
- 16. Bicycles, skateboards, and rollerblades/skates/scooters are not permitted at any City tennis facility. Bicycles and scooters can be locked at the bike rack in the tennis center parking garage during your court reservation.
- 17. In consideration of our neighbors and other patrons, please keep the noise level down and refrain from using inappropriate language. Playing unauthorized or inappropriate music, or exhibiting loud and disruptive behavior, may result in the forfeiture of court time.
- 18. Smoking on the courts or any City premises is prohibited.

- 19. Black soled shoes that leave marks, or inappropriate shoes for play, will not be allowed on the courts.
- 20. Appropriate attire is required at all times. Going shirtless on the court, or around the facility, is not allowed.
- 21. Tennis/Pickleball facility users may not bring animals (except service animals) into the Tennis/Pickleball facilities or leave them unattended. Any patron entering the Tennis/Pickleball facility with a service animal must carry a doggy bag with them at all times.
