1) Review the City of Beverly Hills' Proposed 2020 Legislative Platform

- The Liaisons recommended that the City support any legislations that proposes tax incremental financing (TIF) for the funding of affordable housing
- The Liaisons recommended supporting "common sense" gun legislation be added to the legislative platform. Additionally, they also recommended supporting legislation, which addresses the issues caused by "ghost guns."
- Recommended that a staff report be provided at a future study session on requiring a local gun license.

2) Request Direction on California Proposition - California Criminal Sentencing, Parole, and DNA Collection Initiative (2020), formerly known as the Keeping California Safe Act of 2018

- The Liaisons are in support of the Keeping California Safe Act of 2018 and staff recommendations.
