## **A Response to Comments of Brian Goldberg**

Beverly Hills - In response to comments made on April 14, 2015 by Beverly Hills School Board President Brian Goldberg, the Beverly Hills Police Department would like to offer the following facts.

On March 9, 2015, the Beverly Hills Police Department responded to a call from a young woman complaining of injuries from an assault and battery. A request was made by the complainant for a private person's arrest of Dr. Goldberg. The Beverly Hills Police Department followed standard protocol in responding to this request, including transportation and booking at the station for an alleged crime of violence.

Dr. Goldberg's position had no influence on the officers who responded to the request for the private person's arrest.

Videotape of the incident was not reviewable at the time of the request for the private person's arrest. The following day, BHPD crime scene investigators recovered the video from the building management.
