March 27, 2022 – April 2, 2022

Dear Mr. Welch and Ms. Wilson:

Environmental Intelligence, LLC (EI) has been retained by the City of Beverly Hills (COBH) and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) to serve as the independent compliance monitor (ICM) during construction of the Purple Line Extension Project. Monitoring is required to ensure that construction is in compliance with the "Memorandum of Agreement for Contract C1120 of the Purple Line Extension Project - Between the City of Beverly Hills and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority" (Final Version 62). The following information summarizes the ICM monitoring activities that occurred at the Segment 2 site (Rodeo Station site) during the week of March 27, 2022 – April 2, 2022.

Construction activities during the week included installation and removal of lane closures; pouring concrete and asphalt for pothole and road restoration on S. Canon Dr. and S. Beverly Dr.; pouring concrete within the Reeves yard; decking panel removal; receiving material and equipment deliveries; lowering materials through the deck on Wilshire Blvd. and within the Reeves yard; conducting construction support activities within the station; filling gaps between decking panels with cold mix asphalt; and sweeping and cleaning the work sites and equipment. In addition, EI ICMs conducted sound monitoring and MOA compliance reviews near the back alley of the Beverly Hills High School bungalows adjacent to the project site. EI ICMs were present during all construction activities and conducted routine noise measurements at selected noise monitoring locations as well as compliance checks in accordance with the MOAs and associated attachments, exhibits, traffic closure notifications, and traffic management plans. At the conclusion of each work shift, daily monitoring reports were prepared by each ICM. Attachment B (*Daily Monitoring Reports*) provides detailed daily monitoring reports and photographs of construction activities.

VIOLATION SUMMARY

During the week, EI ICMs identified four (4) violation during construction activities. Table I provides a summary of the violation identified during the week of March 27, 2022 to April 2, 2022. Exhibit 1 provides a location map for the submitted violation. Details for the violation are included as Attachment A. Daily monitoring reports and photographs of construction activities are provided as Attachment B (*Daily Monitoring Reports*). Daily noise monitoring data are provided in Attachment C (*Noise Monitoring Data Log*).

To date, 567 violations have been issued, twenty-one (21) of which have been rescinded since the beginning of construction of the Purple Line Extension Project – Segment 2. Please note, no Violation 261 was ever issued, therefore it is skipped in the numbering sequence and is omitted from this count. Project construction activities are ongoing and EI ICMs continue to monitor all construction activities applicable to the MOA on a daily basis.
