Dear Ms. Chung and Mr. Varley:

Environmental Intelligence, LLC (EI) has been retained by the City of Beverly Hills (COBH) and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) to serve as the independent compliance monitor (ICM) during construction of the Purple Line Extension Project. Monitoring is required to ensure that construction is in compliance with the "Memorandum of Agreement for Contract C1120 of the Purple Line Extension Project - Between the City of Beverly Hills and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority" (Final Version 62). The following information summarizes the ICM monitoring activities that occurred at the Segment 2 site (Rodeo Station site) during the week of July 24, 2022 – July 30, 2022.

Construction activities at Rodeo Station during the week included: implementing and removing lane closures; receiving and lowering rebar deliveries through the deck panel access on Wilshire Blvd.; lifting equipment, construction debris and trash through the deck panel access; geotechnical instrument maintenance; underground tunnel boring support work; and maintenance work below the decking on Wilshire Blvd. Cross passages work at Lasky Dr. and Spalding Dr. consisted of removing and replacing steel plates, excavating trenches, loading spoils into haul trucks and removing them from the site; installing casings and pipes; receiving and pouring concrete and asphalt deliveries; drilling and backfilling dewatering wells; saw-cutting, grinding and breaking pavement; relocating K-Rail barriers, fencing and sound panels; and sweeping and cleaning the worksite. EI ICMs were present during all construction activities and conducted routine noise measurements at selected noise monitoring locations as well as compliance checks in accordance with the MOAs and associated attachments, exhibits, traffic closure notifications, and traffic management plans. At the conclusion of each work shift, daily monitoring reports were prepared by each ICM. Attachment B (*Daily Monitoring Reports*) provides detailed daily monitoring reports and photographs of construction activities.

VIOLATION SUMMARY

During the week, EI ICMs identified two (2) violations during construction activities. Table I provides a summary of the violations identified during the week of July 24, 2022 to July 30, 2022. Exhibit 1 provides a location map for the submitted violations. Details for the violations are included as Attachment A. Daily monitoring reports and photographs of construction activities are provided as Attachment B (*Daily Monitoring Reports*). Daily noise monitoring data are provided in Attachment C (*Noise Monitoring Data Log*).

To date, 593 violations have been issued, twenty-one (21) of which have been rescinded since the beginning of construction of the Purple Line Extension Project – Segment 2. Please note, no Violation 261 was ever issued, therefore it is skipped in the numbering sequence and is omitted from this count. Project construction activities are ongoing and EI ICMs continue to monitor all construction activities applicable to the MOA on a daily basis.
