Traffic Advisory for Presidential Visit

Beverly Hills, Calif. - To assist the public in avoiding possible traffic congestion during the visit of the President of the United States on **Tuesday, February 18, 2020**, the following areas of Beverly Hills should be avoided when possible to prevent travel delays for community members:

INTERMITTENT CLOSURES

The following roadways will be intermittently closed between **3:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m.** and again between **6:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.:**

- The area around Robertson Boulevard between the City of Beverly Hills' southern border (Whitworth Drive) & Wilshire Boulevard
- The area around Wilshire Boulevard between Robertson Boulevard & Beverly Drive
- The area around Crescent Drive between Wilshire Boulevard & N. Santa Monica Boulevard

COMPLETE CLOSURES

The following roadways will be completely closed between **12:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.:**

- Beverly Drive between Wilshire Boulevard and Dayton Way
- Canon Drive between Wilshire Boulevard and Dayton Way
- Clifton Way between Crescent Drive and Canon Drive
- Crescent Drive between North and South Santa Monica Boulevards (closed between **10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.**)
