Dear Ms. Chung and Mr. DeMello,

Environmental Intelligence, LLC (EI) has been retained by the City of Beverly Hills (COBH) and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) to serve as the independent compliance monitor (ICM) during construction of the Purple Line Extension Project. Monitoring is required to ensure construction is in compliance with the MOA for Contract C1045 of the Purple Line Extension Project – Segment 1 – Between the City of Beverly Hills and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (City Agreement No. 66-16). The following information summarizes the ICM monitoring activities that occurred at the Segment 1 site (La Cienega Station site) during the week of **June 12, 2022 – June 18, 2022**.

Construction activities during the week included: excavating Appendage AD within the N. Gale Dr. closure and removing the spoils from the site; pouring concrete within the N. Gale Dr. closure and La Cienega yard; installing GVM, elevator casings, roof system, rebar, conduit and 12x12 timbers; hoisting machinery, debris, materials and equipment in/out of the tunnel in the Gale yard; receiving materials deliveries to the Gale yard; removing materials through the station access closure at Tower Dr.; transporting machinery in the N. Gale Dr. closure and Gale yard; work below deck and within the appendages; breaking concrete segments with a jack-hammer in the Gale yard; hauling broken concrete pieces from the gale yard; reshoring openings in Block 17; general cleaning and clearing of debris from the appendages, closures, yards, and below the deck on Wilshire Blvd. EI ICMs were present on site during all construction activities. ICMs conducted routine noise measurements at selected noise monitoring locations as well as compliance checks in accordance with the MOAs and associated attachments, exhibits, traffic closure notifications, and traffic management plans. At the conclusion of each work shift, daily monitoring reports were prepared by the respective ICM. Any violations for that date were also prepared by the ICM then reviewed and submitted to the COBH and Metro by EI's Project Manager.

VIOLATION SUMMARY

During the week, EI ICMs identified no violations during construction activities. Daily monitoring reports and photographs of construction activities are provided as Attachment A (*Daily Monitoring Reports*). Daily noise monitoring data are provided in Attachment B (*Noise Monitoring Data Log*).
