January 19, 2019 – January 25, 2020

Dear Mr. Welch and Mr. Comorre:

Environmental Intelligence, LLC (EI) has been retained by the City of Beverly Hills (COBH) and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) to serve as the independent compliance monitor (ICM) during construction of the Purple Line Extension Project. Monitoring is required to ensure that construction is in compliance with the "Memorandum of Agreement for Contract C1120 of the Purple Line Extension Project - Between the City of Beverly Hills and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority" (Final Version 62). The following information summarizes the ICM monitoring activities that occurred at the Segment 2 site (Rodeo Station site) during the week of January 19, 2020 – January 25, 2020. No construction activities were scheduled or monitored on January 19th or January 20th 2020.

Construction activities during the week included breaking asphalt and utility potholing in preparation for pile installation activities on Wilshire Blvd., removal of abandoned water lines and storm water catch basin structure, preparation for water line lateral connections at AKA and Montage alleys, N. Beverly Dr. and N. Canon Dr. cul-de-sac, assembling drilling equipment within K-rail and cleaning work sites. In addition, EI ICMs conducted sound monitoring near the back alley of the Beverly Hills High School bungalows adjacent to the project site. EI ICMs were present during all construction activities and conducted routine noise measurements at selected noise monitoring locations as well as compliance checks in accordance with the MOAs and associated attachments, exhibits, traffic closure notifications, and traffic management plans. At the conclusion of each work shift, daily monitoring reports were prepared by each ICM. Attachment B (*Daily Monitoring Reports*) provides detailed daily monitoring reports and photographs of construction activities.

VIOLATION SUMMARY

During the week, EI ICMs identified three (3) violation during construction activities. Table I provides a summary of the violations identified during the week of January 19, 2020 to January 25, 2020 and Exhibit 1 provides a location map for the submitted violations. Details for the violations are included as Attachment A. Daily monitoring reports and photographs of construction activities are provided as Attachment B (*Daily Monitoring Reports*). Daily noise monitoring data are provided in Attachment C (*Noise Monitoring Data Log*).
