Subject: Segment 1 - Purple Line Extension Project ICM Weekly Report
February 6, 2022 – February 12, 2022

Dear Mr. Welch and Mr. DeMello,

Environmental Intelligence, LLC (EI) has been retained by the City of Beverly Hills (COBH) and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) to serve as the independent compliance monitor (ICM) during construction of the Purple Line Extension Project. Monitoring is required to ensure construction is in compliance with the MOA for Contract C1045 of the Purple Line Extension Project – Segment 1 – Between the City of Beverly Hills and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (City Agreement No. 66-16). The following information summarizes the ICM monitoring activities that occurred at the Segment 1 site (La Cienega Station site) during the week of February 6, 2022 – February 12, 2022. No construction activities were scheduled or monitored on February 6, 2022.

Construction activities during the week included hauling spoils from the Gale yard closure and La Cienega yard; pouring concrete into the appendage from the K-rail closure on Wilshire Blvd.; potholing to identify utility locations and excavating appendage AD within the Gale Dr. closure; shoring block 6 concourse; receiving rebar, lumber and materials deliveries to the site; installing forms, conduit and rebar; lifting machinery, debris, materials and equipment into and out of the tunnel within the Gale yard and K-rail closure on Wilshire Blvd.; and general housekeeping activities throughout the site. EI ICMs were present on site during all construction activities. ICMs conducted routine noise measurements at selected noise monitoring locations as well as compliance checks in accordance with the MOA and associated attachments, exhibits, traffic closure notifications, and traffic management plans. At the conclusion of each work shift, daily monitoring reports were prepared by the respective ICM. Any violations for that date were also prepared by the ICM then reviewed and submitted to the COBH and Metro by EI's Project Manager.

VIOLATION SUMMARY

During the week, EI ICMs identified a total of one (1) violation during construction activities. Table I provides a summary of the violation identified during the week of February 6, 2022 – February 12, 2022 and Exhibit 1 provides a location map for the submitted violation. Details for the violation are included as Attachment A. Daily monitoring reports and photographs of construction activities are provided as Attachment B. Daily noise monitoring data are provided in Attachment C.



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CONCLUSION

To date, 308 violations have been issued, 19 of which have been rescinded since the beginning of construction on the C1045 Contract for the Purple Line Extension Project – Segment 1. Project construction activities are ongoing and EI ICMs continue to monitor all construction activities applicable to the MOAs on a daily basis.
