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Beverly Hills Recreation and Parks Commission will Hold Public Discussion on Personal Training in Beverly Hills Public Parks

Beverly Hills, CA – The City of Beverly Hills Recreation and Parks Commission invites the public to voice their opinion about possible issuance of City permits to conduct personal training in the park for compensation. Public comment will be heard at the regularly scheduled Recreation and Parks Commission Meeting on Tuesday, November 24, 2015 at 2 p.m. at Beverly Hills City Hall, 455 North Rexford Drive, Room 280A.

Currently, use of the City parks for private or group instruction for compensation without a permit is not allowed but enforcement is lean. Due to an influx of private training, use of some facilities and grounds is affecting other citizens so the City is considering strict enforcement of issuance of permits to private trainers to conduct business in select Beverly Hills parks. The City is looking to satisfy the needs of personal trainers as well as community members.
