The Summer Reading Club theme for 2015 is "Read to the Rhythm" which will incorporate musical events and activities into the program's offerings. "The Summer Reading Club is a very popular program," says Nancy Hunt-Coffey, Assistant Director of Community Services for the City of Beverly Hills, "and we are very proud to see the community engage in our programs and utilize the many resources that the Library offers."

Summer Reading Club encourages reading throughout the summer by providing an incentive when participants reach a reading goal.
