Beverly Hills City Council Meetings to Return In-Person March 15 *In-Person Commission Meetings to Follow*

Beverly Hills, CA – The Beverly Hills City Council this week unanimously approved the return of in-person City Council meetings beginning Tuesday, March 15, 2022 with the option for the public to still watch and comment virtually if desired at [beverlyhills.org](https://www.beverlyhills.org)

The decision comes as the result of a drop in COVID cases and the gradual relaxing of restrictions across Los Angeles County.

Commission meetings will begin returning in-person later this month based on noticing requirements.

Upon returning to in-person meetings in City Hall, the public will need to abide by the most updated LACDPH Health Officer Order that relates to masking and vaccination guidelines.
