



Construction Activity Regulations

Hours of Construction:

No person shall engage in construction, maintenance or repair work which requires a City permit between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. of any day, or at any time on a Sunday or public holiday unless such person has been issued an after-hours construction permit.

Restrictions on Construction Activity:

No person shall engage in such work within a residential zone, or within five hundred (500) feet of a residential zone, at any time on a Saturday unless such person has been issued an after-hours construction permit. For the purpose of this Section, "Public Holiday" shall mean:

- (1) New Year's Day
- (2) Martin Luther King Jr. Day
- (3) Presidents Day
- (4) Memorial Day
- (5) Independence Day
- (6) Labor Day
- (7) Yom Kippur
- (8) Veterans Day
- (9) Thanksgiving Day
- (10) The Friday following Thanksgiving Day
- (11) Christmas Day.

No person employed for the purposes of construction, maintenance, or repair work which requires a city permit shall enter a site on which such work will be done prior to 8:00 a.m. Any violation of this condition shall be deemed to be an infraction."

Special Inspection/Investigation Fee:

A special inspection fee may be assessed by the building official or his technical officers, inspectors, and other employees as determined necessary to achieve compliance of the permitted work and/or related activity. Such enforcement shall result from those actions and/or a violation(s) of Beverly Hills Municipal code associated with the permitted work and/or related activity caused by property owner, contractor, its employees, and/or persons working under the control and direction of contractor.
