GUIDELINES

- Priorities setting is done annually
- 6 priority areas
- Priority areas should be as narrowly-focused as possible
- Avoid selecting priority areas the City is already adequately meeting
- Objective is to launch at least one initiative per priority area during the year
- OK for an initiative to hit multiple priority areas
- Each committee member can vote up to six priorities only (*online voting system will be provided*)
- The top six priorities with the highest votes will be 2019 priorities.
