The Community Is Invited to a Free Anniversary Concert at the Wallis

Concert Features the Celebrated Choir of the Faithful Central Bible Church Seating is Limited and Reservations Are Required!

Beverly Hills, CA – The City of Beverly Hills, The North Homeowners Association and the Beverly Hills Municipal League are sponsoring a free gospel concert to mark the 25th anniversary of a similar concert that was held 25 years ago following the 1992 Los Angeles riots. The performance, by the Faithful Central Bible Church of Inglewood, will be held Sun. Jan. 21 at 6 p.m. at the Wallis Annenberg Center for the Performing Arts.

In 1992, the City of Beverly Hills coproduced a concert featuring performers from the same church, at that time called Faithful Central Missionary Baptist Church. The purpose of the original concert, held at the Beverly Hills High School Auditorium, was to promote unity and tolerance in the Los Angeles region following the riots. The video that was made of the concert won the Cable ACE Award for Best Documentary in the Cultural Affairs category.

The 2018 concert will feature the renowned singers and dancers from the Faithful Central Bible Church and a brief video excerpt from the original concert.
