

1 For meter larger than 6", applicant will submit calculations estimating annual water demand for review and approval and determination of the Water Supply Fee

B. For a residential or commercial property which requires the size of the water meter to be increased, the water supply fee will be the amount of water supply fee for the size of the new meter less the amount of the water supply fee for the size of the existing meter, as such amounts are indicated in the paragraph A above.

- C. For a residential project which does not require the size of the water meter to be increased but results in a net new floor area greater than 1,000 square feet, the water supply fee will be an amount which is \$1.74 per square foot of net new floor area greater than 1,000 square feet.
- D. For a commercial project that does not require the size of the water meter to be increased, or if the project does not require the size of the meter to be increased but results in a change of commercial use, the water supply fee shall be based on the net increase in service units as follows:
