RIGHT OF WAY CONSTRUCTION HOLIDAY SAFETY MEASURES NOVEMBER 10, 2019 – JANUARY 5, 2020

The winter holiday season is a busy time for Beverly Hills residents and businesses, with a great deal of shopping, celebratory and travel-related activities occurring throughout the community. During this time, the City of Beverly Hills reviews public right of way uses (streets, alleys, sidewalks, and curb lanes) to account for the increase in traffic and pedestrian activities. In order to encourage safety during the holiday season, the following special construction safety measures will be initiated by the City during the above specified period for the areas denoted on the attached map. Any exception to the holiday safety measures will be considered on a case-by-case basis, including adherence to special permit conditions as imposed to mitigate interference with holiday activities.

- 1. Only excavations of an emergency nature will be permitted in the public right-of-way and, where possible, shall be restricted to night hours or Weekends. If determined necessary to expedite completion of such emergency work, it may be permitted for the project to be carried forward on a 24-hour basis, provided this would not be in conflict with existing regulations regarding proximity to residential zoning.
- 2. All public utility companies, contractors and others are hereby notified that all excavations in said streets or other places on public right-of-way commenced prior to the restriction period must be in such condition that they will be resurfaced prior to November 10, 2019.
- 3. All other activity proposed within public right-of-way, whether construction related or otherwise, which would normally require a permit and would constitute any form of obstruction to vehicular or pedestrian traffic within the designated area may be conditioned to specific hours and/or days during which the activity may be performed. All project and permit renewals shall be reviewed for the purpose of facilitating public safety.
