Our experienced Nurse Practitioner and Paramedic team cares for each patient in the comfort of their own home.

We provide mobile urgent care type services, as well as more comprehensive assessments, that help prevent hospital readmissions and improve coordination of care, including:

- ▶ Point of care testing
 - Chem8, Hgb, UA, strep
- ▶ Medication reconciliation
- ▶ Suturing & wound care
- ▶ EKG, pulse oximetry
- ▶ IV fluids & IV antibiotics
- ▶ High risk patient follow-ups
- ▶ DME ordering/coordination
- ▶ Non-narcotic analgesics
- ▶ Case management
- ▶ Social services referrals
- ▶ and more!



Coverage Territory:

- Residents presently residing in Beverly Hills

Who can call NPRU?

- Physicians, nurses, and other members of health care that identify a potential need for in-home close assessment and/or care coordination
- BH residents and family members who need help obtaining resources and care

Do we call 911 or NPRU?

- For any possible life-threatening emergencies, please call 911
- If NPRU is on scene and the need ER care arises, EMS will be contacted per protocol

How do you assist with ongoing needs?

- We can provide both immediate and follow-up care. If additional care needs arise, we can help coordinate and refer to appropriate agencies.
- We collaborate across different City departments and private organizations, including but not limited to: social services, Code Enforcement, Police, private doctors, and home health agencies to help residents achieve or maintain optimal health.

What specific medications and diagnostics do you have available (as supplies allow)?

- POC: Abbott Chem 8+ (chemistry, hgb/hct), Rapid Strep A, UCG, UA Dip, Rapid Influenza A/B
- SARS-CoV-2 PCR testing for qualifying patients, as supplies allow
- EKG, BP, Temp, Pulse Oximetry
- IV: NS, LR, ondansetron, ceftriaxone, ketorolac
- PO: ondansetron, ciprofloxacin, doxycycline, ibuprofen, diphenhydramine, acetaminophen, sulfamethoxazole-trimethoprim, meclizine, clindamycin, Imodium
- IM: ondansetron, ceftriaxone, ketorolac, lidocaine, Tdap, influenza vaccine
- Nebulizer: albuterol, ipratropium bromide+albuterol
- Topical: silver sulfadiazine, lidocaine/prilocaine, silver nitrate sticks
